69.2% of all papers were awarded the top A* grade. 93.3% of all papers were awarded A* or A grades. 55 girls gained all A* or A grades and 14 girls gained all A* grades. In Further Mathematics 33% of candidates achieved the highest grade of an A* with Distinction.

Most girls studied for 9 full GCSEs, plus the OCR Level 2 National Award in ICT, which has equivalence to half (Short Course) or one (Full Award) further GCSE pass at grades A*, A or B.

In the additional ICT qualification, at the Full Award 72 girls passed with Distinction and 2 with Merit, and in the Short Course 2 girls passed with Distinction and 1 with Merit.
