69% of all papers were awarded the top A* grade. 93% of all papers were awarded A* or A grades. 43 girls gained all A* or A grades and 12 girls gained all A* grades. In Further Mathematics 41% of candidates achieved the highest grade of an A* with Distinction. Most girls studied for 10 full GCSE/IGCSEs, including a full GCSE in IT (ECDL). Passes in Latin and Greek GCSE Short Courses are recorded in the table above at their equivalence of 0.5 of a GCSE pass.
