N GIRLS' JUNIOR SCHOOL

MATHEMATICS

We use a variety of textbooks and workbooks with the girls as well as practical equipment and resources. This helps us to cater for different learning styles and gives pupils the experience of different types of questions. Each week there is time allocated to a times tables test and problem-solving activities.

ENGLISH

Throughout the week, the girls will be working on creative writing, comprehension, grammar, spellings and handwriting. We ask that they read for 20 minutes every evening; books can be selected from home or the Junior Library.

HOMEWORK

The girls will have approximately 20 minutes of written homework three times a week as well as their 20 minutes of reading. We also have a spelling and times tables test each week.



EXTRA ACTIVITIES

We have a dynamic timetable and the opportunity to use the facilities across the whole school, such as the ICT suite, Science Laboratory, Junior Hall, Art and DT room, Sports Hall, Gym and outside on the Astro turf. As well as this there are also other activities available to the girls before and after school and at lunchtime, such as Pets Club, Gym Club, Tennis, Chess Club and Yoga.

LUNCHTIME

The girls are offered a variety of choices at lunchtime; there is a vegetarian option as well as a salad bar available everyday. The girls can bring in their own snacks for playtime or they can buy something from the Snack Bar.

TRANSPORT

If girls catch the bus to School we can organise a bus buddy for them from one of the older classes to help them get on the bus and remind them where to get off!

BEFORE & AFTER SCHOOL

We have a supervised Breakfast Club from 8am onwards in the morning and girls can also stay in the supervised late room facility until 5:15pm. There is no additional charge for these activities.

Means-tested bursaries are available for Years 5 and 6.
