

IMPACT EVALUATION



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IMPACT STATEMENT:

Withington's SHiNE Saturday morning education courses were run for the 14th year in Spring 2022. 90 boys and girls in Years 5 and 6 from 15 maintained Manchester Primary schools attended one of six subject courses offered free of charge during the Spring Term. Six-week courses ran in school for Complete Creativity, Computing, Drama and Science. We also had a four-week German course delivered in school and a four-week online course in Creative Writing.

In questionnaires that were answered at the end of the course 86% of pupils said that they had really enjoyed coming to SHiNE Together and 86% of pupils said that coming to SHiNE Together had made them more confident in that subject. An impressive 97% said that they would recommend SHiNE Together to their friends.

In the parental questionnaires, also collected at the end of the course, 90% of parents said that their child was more enthusiastic about the subject now and 93% said that their child's confidence had increased, with 97% saying they would recommend SHiNE Together to others.

Whilst the number of sixth former volunteers was very limited this year due to covid restrictions, this remains a key aim of our SHINE Together programme and one which we hope to continue in full next year.
