97.2% of all papers were awarded A\* or A grades. 60 girls gained all A\* or A grades. 28 girls gained 10 A\* grades, 6 girls gained 11 A\* grades and one girl gained 12 A\* grades.  
Most girls took 1 short course and 9 full GCSEs. The pass rate was 100%.
